
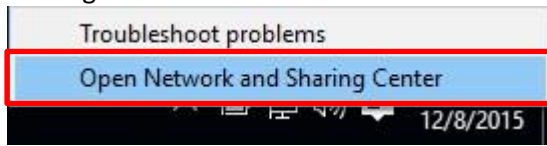
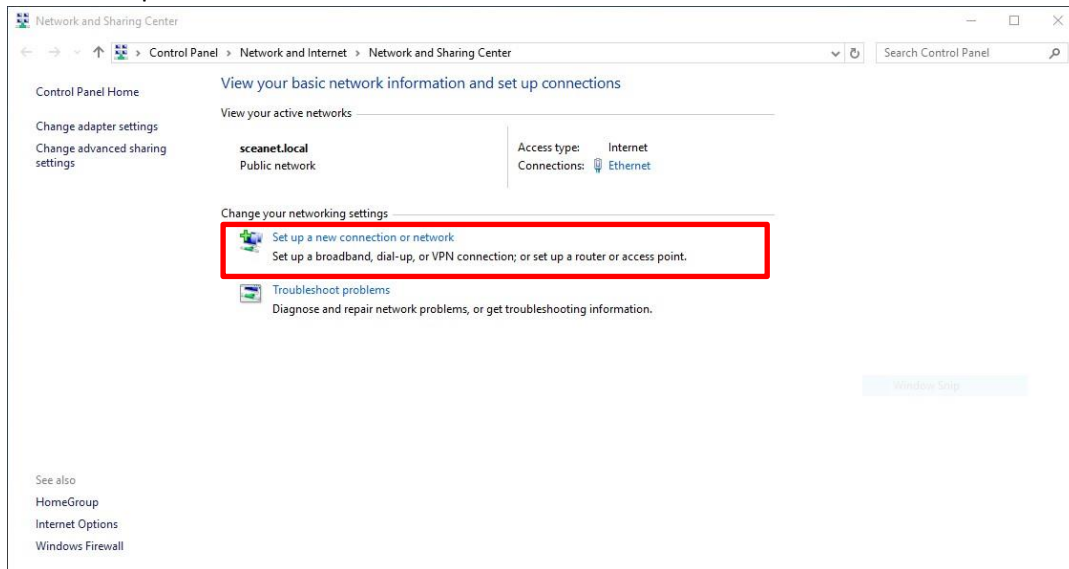


Connecting Windows 10 to the College Wi-Fi

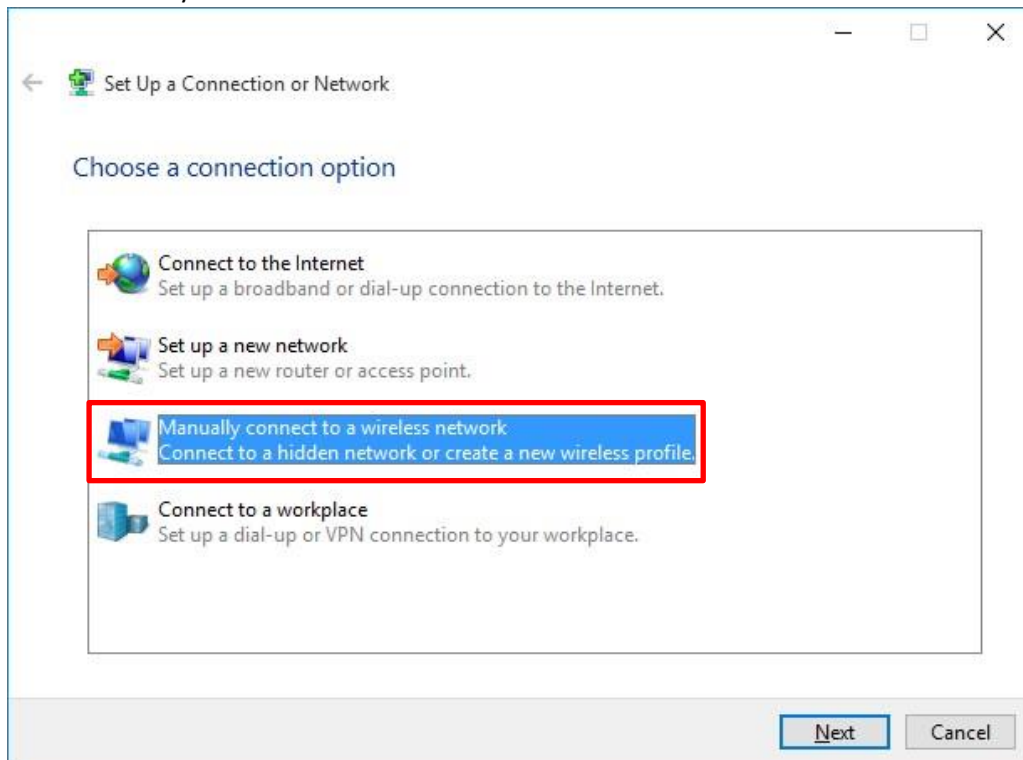
Right-click on the wireless network icon  in the system tray and then click “Open Network and Sharing Center”.



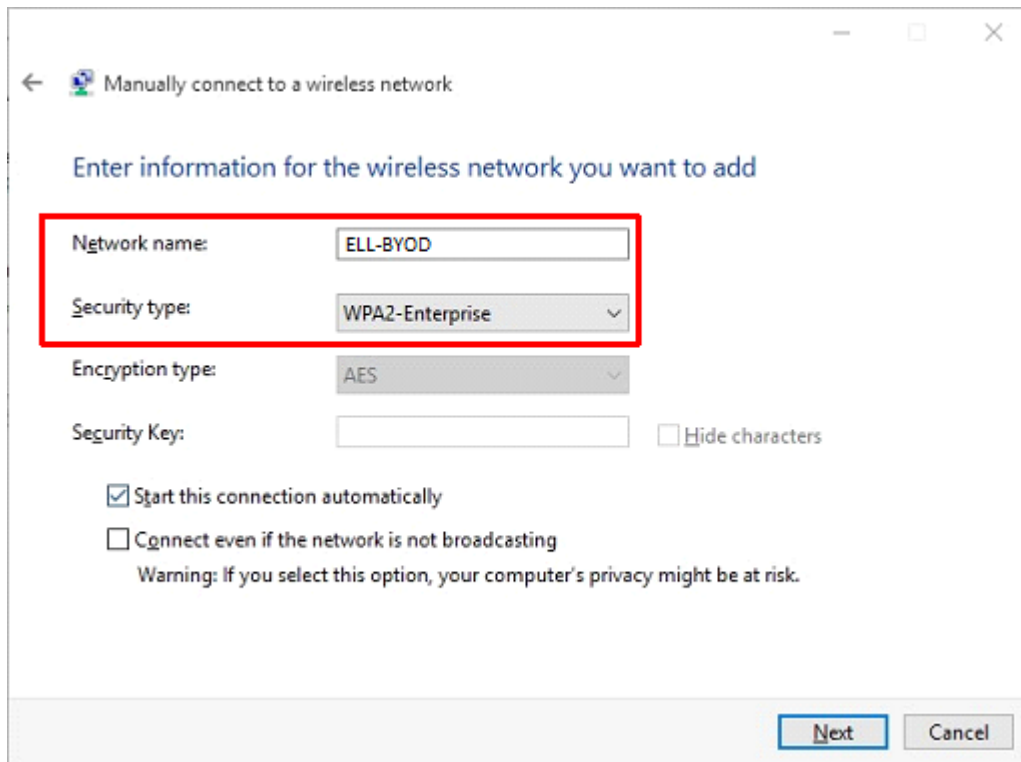
Click “Set up a new connection or network”.



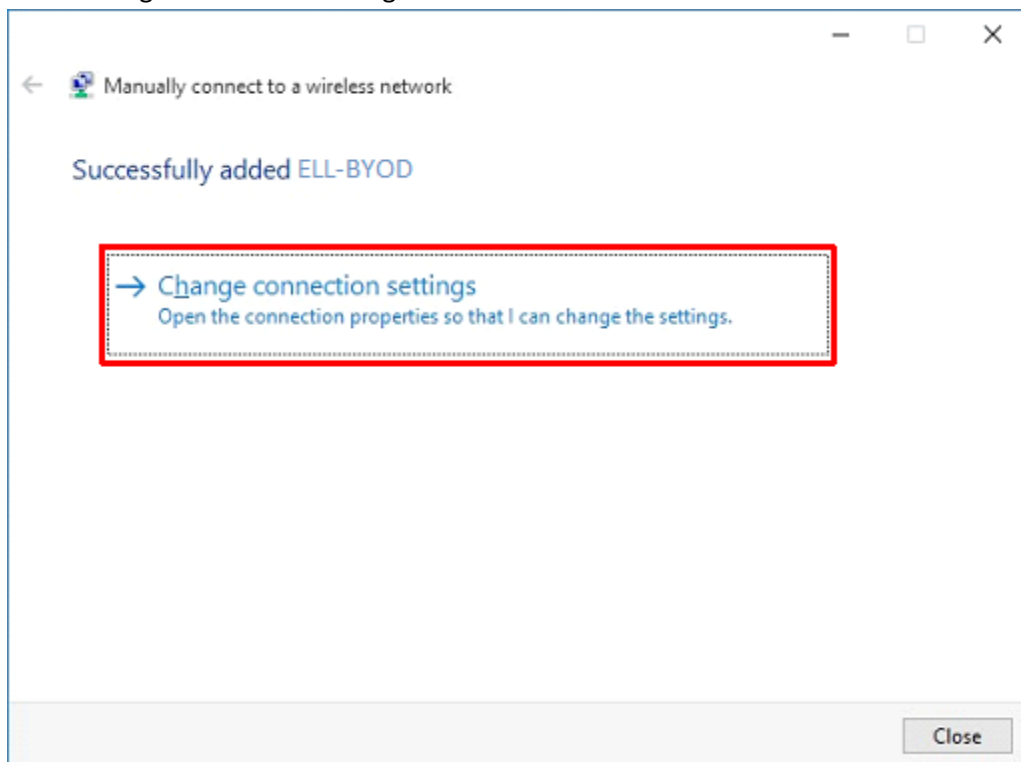
Click “Manually connect to a wireless network”.



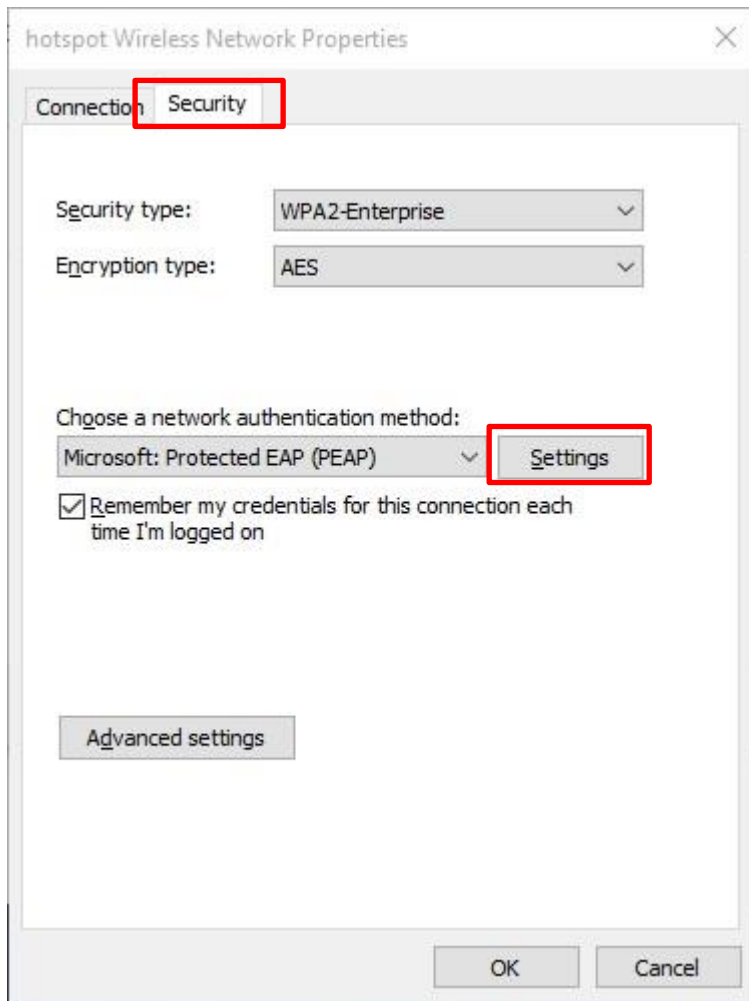
Enter the details as shown in the screenshot below and click “Next”.



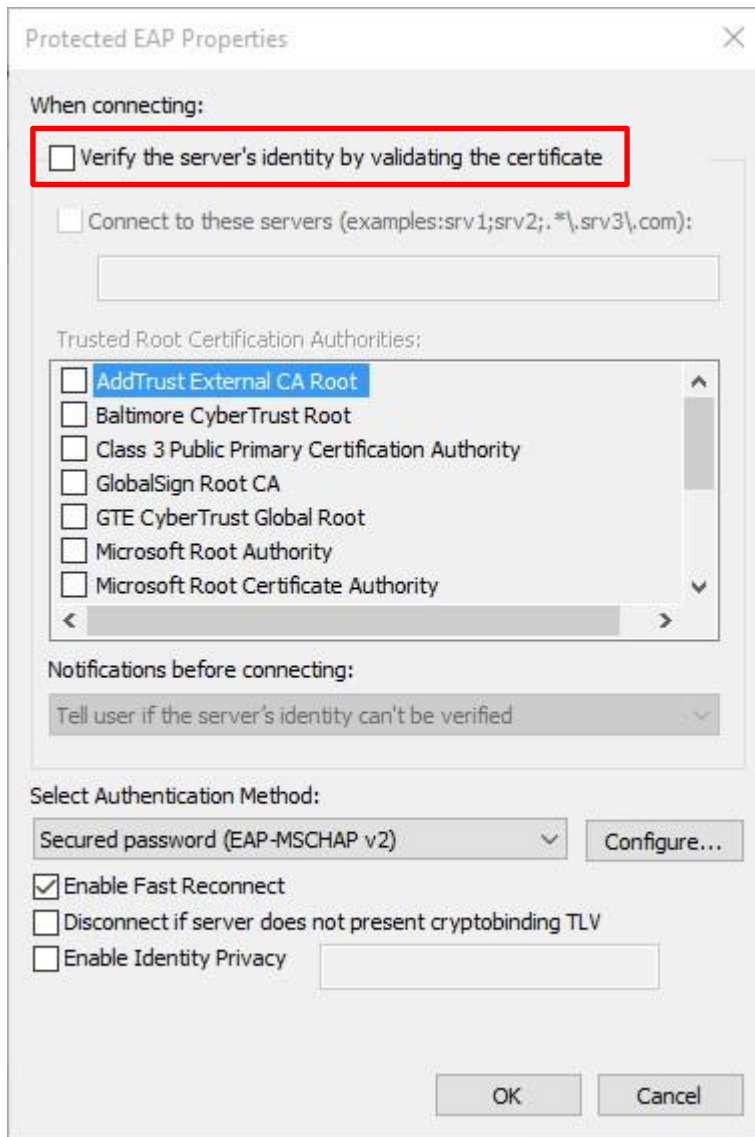
Click "Change connection settings".



On the "Security" tab click on "Settings".

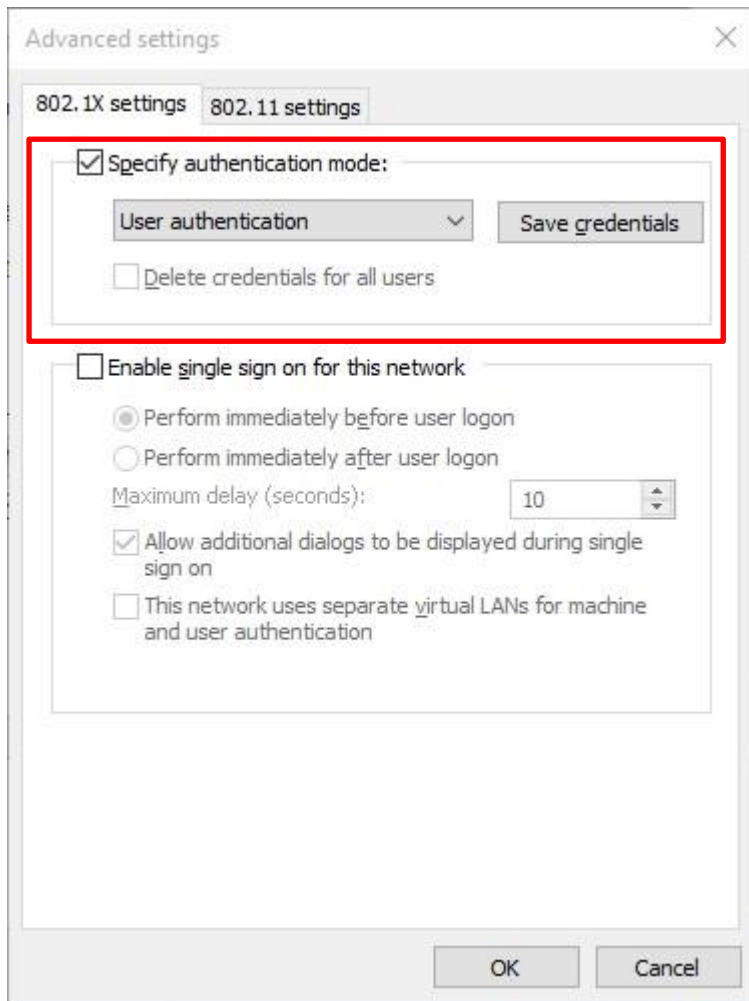


Remove the tick from “Verify the server’s identity by validating the certificate” and click “OK”.

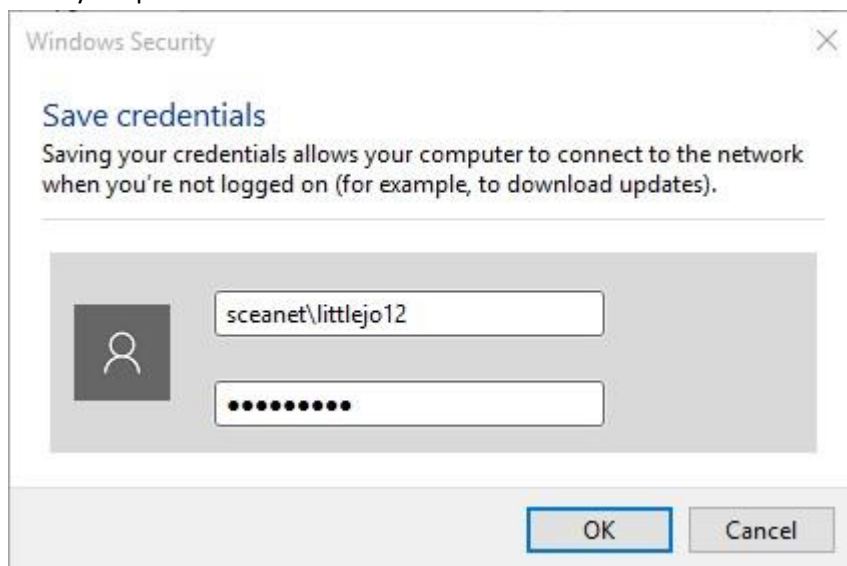


In the "ELL-BYOD wireless network properties" window, click "Advanced settings".

In the "Advanced settings" window, check the box labelled "Specify authentication mode" and then select "User authentication" from the drop-down list and click "Save credentials".



Enter your school user account prefixed with “sceanet\” as shown in the screenshot below, and then enter your password and click “OK”.
